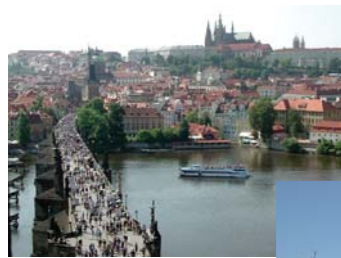


# SIGHTSEEING AND TOURS

## GRAND TOUR OF PRAGUE – FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 22, 2006



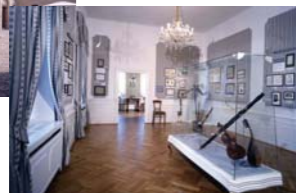

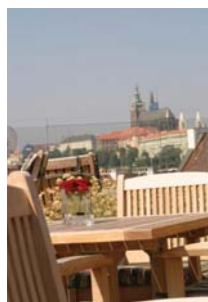
